- ♦ Enrollment is on a first come, first served basis. Unless otherwise noted, grade level refers to the grade going into next year. Class size will be limited by the size of the facility. For bookkeeping purposes, it is requested that separate checks be made for each child registering. Courses may be cancelled for lack of enrollment or staff availability. A refund of tuition will then be made. Where possible, students will be grouped according to age and experience.
- ♦ Tuition Refund: Withdrawal may be made before the first day of class. Tuition will be refunded, minus a \$10.00 registration FEE. No tuition fee will be refunded for any reason after the first class.
- ◆ **Transportation:** Parents must provide transportation to and from summer school. Students should arrive and depart from classes with a minimum of waiting.

READING COURSES



◆ ROAR INTO READING (Grades K-2)

Come one, come all and get ready to roar! Building a foundation for early readers in literacy and focusing on vocabulary and reading comprehension. Roar into Reading will inspire both confidence and the appreciation for the love of reading. While exploring both fiction and non-fiction material this course will focus on phonics, vocabulary, writing, and reading comprehension skills and strategies. **Please select (9:00 or 10:00 a.m.). COST: \$85.00**

♦ READING DETECTIVES (Grades 2-3, 4-5)

This class is aimed at enhancing and improving decoding and spelling skills. Using a variety of approaches, students can enrich their reading skills and have fun at the same time. Different strategies including games, and hands-on activities will be utilized. (This is not a remedial course.)

(Will be offered at 9:00a.m. - Grades 2-3), (10:00a.m. - Grades 4-5) COST: \$85.00

◆ PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS (Grades K-1)

This course focuses on phonological awareness. Phonological awareness is the awareness of sounds in a language. It practices rhyming, recognizing sounds, separating sounds, blending sounds, as well as manipulating sounds. Phonological awareness provides the base a child needs to learn to read and write. Phonological awareness is built through oral language activities. As a child learns to hear, identify and change pieces of language, they are preparing themselves to read written language. In this course, we will do activities that build phonological awareness through the use of interactive games and songs that children will enjoy! (Will be offered at 10:00 a.m.). COST: \$85.00

SCHOOL READINESS COURSES

♦ LET'S GET READY FOR SCHOOL (Kindergarten)

Is your child ready for school? This class provides an excellent kindergarten experience for your child entering school in September. Through games, crafts, and physical activities, your child will develop social skills, which are necessary to succeed. Students will enhance their listening skills through age appropriate stories, songs and poems.

(Will be offered at 9:00a.m.). COST: \$85.00

MATH COURSES

◆ MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH MAGIC (Grades 6-8)

A John Hopkins study found that students lose approximately 2.6 months of grade level equivalency in mathematical computation skills during the summer months. Don't let your math skills get out of shape! Sharpen your skills this summer by practicing decimals, fractions, long division, math facts, geometry, problem solving and more in this course. Students will participate in hands-on math lessons and interesting activities that will help make math fun! (Will be offered at 9:00a.m.) COST: \$85.00

◆ MATH GAMES (Grades K-3)

Learn and review skills through exciting math games! We will play addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division bingo, games involving dice, fraction games, solving problems with math manipulatives, and much more. We will have a great time while strengthening foundation math skills that will build confidence for future grade levels.

♦ FUN WITH MATH (Grades 4-5)

Believe it or not, math can be fun! Review and learn new strategies to enhance math skills through a variety of hands-on activities, techniques, and games. By using different approaches, students can enrich their math skills. Topics that will be covered include: math facts, problem solving, graphing and geometry, among other math related areas.

(Will be offered at 11:00a.m.) COST: \$85.00

WRITING COURSES

♦ JOURNALISM (Grades 4-8)

Students will learn aspects of journalism that will enable them to design their own newspaper. Students will work on articles, artwork, photography, and layout for their publication. In this course, students will build upon their writing, listening, and speaking skills, as well as their ability to work with their fellow student journalists. This hands-on class is filled with fun-filled activities for youngsters to enjoy. The best part about the course is the newspaper, which will reflect each student's creative talents.

(Will be offered at 10:00a.m.) COST: \$85.00 + \$5.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$90.00

◆ CREATIVE WRITING (Grades 4-8)

This summer is a great time for students in grades 4-8 to enhance their writing skills while being creative and having fun! Depending on the interest and needs of the class, various genres of writing will be explored. Students will create many original pieces of writing during this class including descriptive, persuasive, different forms of poetry, newspaper articles, and writing from photography. This is a great way to keep writing skills sharp for the year ahead. (Will be offered at 11:00a.m.) COST: \$85.00 + \$5.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$90.00

♦ WOW: WRITING STORIES (Grades 2-4)

Do you love stories? Do you love to tell, listen and/or write short stories? Each week students will be reading, writing, sharing, and celebrating their work. In this course, whole group, small group, and individualized activities will be used to inspire ideas and craft short story masterpieces that will be shared!

(Will be offered at 9:00a.m.) COST: \$85.00 + \$5.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$90.00

◆ PICTURE BOOK WRITING (Grades 4-6)

Ever dreamed of being an author and writing your own book? Ever wondered what the process is to write your own book and all of the work it takes? Now is your chance to be an author! Throughout the course, students will read and analyze picture books from a variety of authors and genres, comparing different writing styles, as well as the illustrations. Students will then brainstorm different ideas and create a plan for their story, developing their storyboard. During the drafting and editing process, students will share with their peer "editors," where they will give and share feedback, just as authors do! Once the editing process is done, they will create their final, hardcover copy of their picture book, which they will then share with each other during our publishing party. At the end of the session, students will have their very own picture book to bring home to share with their family and friends! (Will be offered at 10:00 a.m.)

SCIENCE COURSES

♦ YOUNG SCIENCE EXPLORERS (Grades K-2)

This class will provide students with an opportunity to engage in a variety of age appropriate science activities and/or experiments. We will reinforce concepts and skills related to earth, life, and physical science. Each lesson includes a hands-on activity exploring topics such as volcanoes, life cycles, fossils, the five senses and magnetism. There will be opportunities for integrating verbal and writing skills while exploring the wonders of science. (Will be offered at 9:00 a.m.) COST: \$85.00 + \$15.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$100.00

♦ LET'S EXPERIMENT (Grades 3-5)

This class has students engaging in a variety of hands-on experiments and activities including making slime, setting off bottle rockets and building solar ovens. Students will explore such concepts as seed germination, recycling, solar energy, chemical reactions and optical illusions. We'll utilize the scientific method including making a hypothesis, collecting data and drawing conclusions all while enjoying the marvels of science.

◆ EXPLORE ENGINEERING (Grades 6-8)

This course is for those interested in design and engineering. We will be designing and creating various projects. Students will have an in-depth understanding of the design and engineering process. Once you have completed the course, you will have a reference binder to re-create your projects. (Will be offered at 10:00 a.m.) COST: \$85.00 + \$20.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$105.00

TECHNOLOGY COURSES

♦ KID'S CLICK (Grades K-4)

Students will be led into the world of technology. Students will be taught keyboarding, basic operational skills, and word processing. Different software programs and the Internet will be used to create projects, play games, and to encourage creativity.

(Will be offered at 11:00 a.m.) COST: \$85.00

♦ FUN WITH DIGITAL VIDEO (Grades 3-8)

This course introduces participants to hands-on activities with a video camera. Utilizing iMovie, students will create video autobiographies from home photographs, demonstrate how-to videos on camera, create clay animation and star in their own music video. Students will learn various roles including talent, director, and camera crew. Each student will take home a DVD of his/her activities upon completion of the program.

(Students do not need to bring their own camera's) (Will be held at 11:00 a.m.) COST: \$85.00 + \$20.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$105.00

♦ WEB TOOLS (Grades 4-8)

Students will be introduced to a variety of web tools that will enable them to create everything from web sites, to music and virtual comics. Students will practice creating presentations and organizing information in Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, Excel, Prezi, and even make their own website on Weebly. (Will be offered at 10:00 a.m.) COST: \$85.00

♦ CODING FOR KIDS (Grades 4-6)

Students will gain an introduction to the world of coding, using the Code.org curriculum. Students will study topics such as: - How the Internet works, - Basic computer, programming, - Logic, problem solving and creativity, - Creating simple apps, animations, and "code art". Coding helps nurture creativity, problem solving, collaboration and logic through interactive, self-paced tutorials, featuring short video lectures and game-like puzzles.

(Will be held at 9:00 a.m.). COST: \$85.00

♦ TYPE-TASTIC! (Grades 1-3, 3-5)

Today, as early as elementary school, keyboarding skills are essential for technology-dependent, learning environments. Without any prior keyboard instruction, many children develop poor finger habits that may interfere with their daily learning experience. Before entering Grade 3, students do not have a dedicated Technology class which would expose them to proper keyboarding weekly. Students entering into Grade 3 should be typing at a rate of 10 words per minute. By the end of Grade 5, students should be typing at a rate of 25 words per minute. Throughout this course, younger students (Grades 1-3) will gain an introduction to keyboarding, using Computer Keyboarding for Beginners curriculum, Typing.com Beginner curriculum and various online keyboarding games. The objective of this course is for students to develop letter recognition/identification, letter memorization, accuracy and confidence in their keyboarding. Older students (Grades 4-5) will build upon their keyboarding skills taught in their weekly Technology class to increase accuracy, typing speed and confidence through interactive lessons and games. (Will be held at 10:00 a.m.). COST: \$85.00

◆ STEAM MAKERSPACE (Grades 1-3 and Grades 3-6)

The Discovery S.T.E.A.M. class is designed to develop invaluable 21st century skills of critical thinking, collaboration, communication, and creativity. Discovery S.T.E.A.M. integrates Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math through hands-on activities and experiments in a student-centered format. Through the use of these themes, students will explore scientific concepts, engage in the design process, work collaboratively and problem solve to complete a different challenge each week. Students will explore concepts such as gravity, air resistance, forces of thrust, drag and lift, tension and compression, measurement, and more by working together to solve a challenge that relates to the theme.

ART COURSES

♦ STORY BOOK ARTS AND CRAFTS (Grades K-3)

Do you love listening to stories? Do you love art projects? Well then come join us as we read a variety of storybooks and create accompanying crafts. Some of the techniques include creating projects utilizing a variety of mediums including pencil and painting. In addition, students will explore color manipulation through paint, as well as the technique of mosaics using different paper textures. Some of the crafts include windsocks, making recycled crayons, butterflies, decorating flowerpots and planting seeds, and much more! Come join the fun as we explore literature through hands-on art projects and activities!

(Will be offered at 10:00 a.m.). COST: \$85.00 + \$20.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$105.00

♦ DUCT TAPE CREATIONS (Grades 5-8)

Duct tape has earned the reputation for being able to fix everything, but did you know it's also a great tool for fashionable accessories and crafts? In this class, students will be able to combine their creativity and craftiness to make a variety of duct tape accessories. Students will learn preliminary skills through simple beginner creations that are the foundation for more complex creations. Crafts will include bookmarks, flowers, bracelets, necklaces, belts, wallets, flip-flops, and more! (Will be offered at 11:00 a.m.) COST: \$85.00 + \$20.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$105.00

♦ ART IN ACTION (Grades 1-3)

This hands-on course will give children the opportunity to explore their creativity as they produce original pieces of artwork. Children will discover their artistic abilities as they experiment with oil pastels, watercolor pencils, chalk pastels, paint, collage, sculpture, and clay. Students will practice techniques to work with each medium and learn about the artist that inspired their project! (Will be offered at 9:00 a.m.) COST: \$85.00 + \$10.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$95.00

♦ CARTOONING (Grades 4-8)

Ever wish there was a class where doodling was allowed and even encouraged? If so, then welcome to the exciting world of cartooning. Learn how to draw a cartoon, create a comic strip and develop stories based on your interests and imagination. Go through the process of devising your very own characters and stories. You will have the opportunity to learn various techniques and styles that will enhance your artistic and creative abilities when it comes to cartooning and comic creation. Everyone has their own style as well as interests and in cartooning you will decide what kind of story and style you would like to animate. The fun will not stop in this course as new ideas will be shared and practiced on a daily basis!

◆ TIE DYING & FRIENDSHIP BRACELET MAKING (Grades 3-8)

Show off your artistic side by designing your own tie-dye shirts. Throughout the course students will be taught several tie-dying techniques, such as bulls eye, bunches, spiral, mirror image, and fish scales. At the end of the course, students have the ability to apply any combination of the learned techniques to any number of other items, including shorts, socks, pillowcases, sheets, etc.! In addition, students will learn friendship bracelet techniques including zigzag, chevron, hearts, waves, and much more! These patterns can be applied to create anklets, necklaces, or key chains, in addition to bracelets.

♦ ART EXPLORATION (Grades 3-5)

There are so many ways to create art: from pencil and crayon to colored pencil, marker, watercolor, tempera paint, printmaking, collage and sculpture, students will explore a little bit of everything in this course! Different themes and subject matter along with bits of art history will be provided as inspiration for all the different projects they will do. Creativity and thinking outside the box will be essential to making this class a memorable experience with many beautiful products. A snack will be provided. (Will be offered at 9:00 am.) COST \$85.00 + \$10.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$95.00.

◆ SCRAPBOOKING IN STYLE (Grades 3-8)

Capture your favorite memories in a custom scrapbook tailored to your personal style. Students will learn how to organize memories into a fun, exciting, and eye-catching book. As part of the organizational process, students can decide how they wish to categorize and present their scrapbook, including a variety of themes or focusing on just one. They will use a variety of papers, stamps, stickers, stencils, and personalized quotes to decorate and design individual pages in their customized book.

(Will be offered at 9:00a.m.) COST \$85.00 + \$20.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$105.00

♦ 1, 2, 3-D! (Grades 4-8)

Do you love to draw and create? Do you have an appreciation for the structure around you? If so, this course is for you! Learn to draw, cut, and refine simple shapes to create three-dimensional objects. Use your creativity to design a model city landscape that pops right off the paper! Use cardboard to build sculptures, people, places, and more! Why keep your art flat on the page, when you can make it 3-D? Please select (9:00 or 11:00am)

COST \$85.00 + \$10.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$95.00

♦ SCULPTURE (Grades 3-6)

Students will be working with clay to create sculptures, pottery, jewelry, as well as learning about how different cultures use clay. We will also work on coiling to create pinch pots and other vessels. This class will use self-hardening clay to create our masterpieces!

(Will be offered at 10:00a.m.) COST \$85.00 + \$10.00 MATERIALS FEE = \$95.00

♦ PHOTOGRAPHY (Grades 4-8)

Photography is a great way to allow kids to explore and expand their creativity. In this fun filled photography class for kids, kids will explore their creativity by experimenting different techniques and types of photography in both indoor and outdoor scenarios. Kids will have the experience of exploring many of the different effects they can achieve in their photos. In addition to learning about their cameras kids will also learn to be creative in the way they frame their images by taking pictures from different perspectives, working on abstract images and learning to explore while they photograph.

♦ BEGINNER THEATER (Grades K-3)

This class for young children will introduce the art, creativity, and excitement of musical theater, puppetry, theater games, costumes, make-up, dancing, and acting. Students will actively participate in individual and group projects as an introduction to beginning theatrics. (Will be held at 11:00a.m.) COST: \$85.00

♦ JUNIOR THEATER WORKSHOP (Grades 4-8)

This class will be a total adventure into the magical world of theater through dramatic exercises and improvisational exploration. Students will have the opportunity to learn skills. that will help them on stage, including presence, confidence, expression, focus and projection. Students will also develop skills that will help them in life, including discipline, integrity, commitment, teamwork and collaboration. Children will learn the history of theater and stage properties while participating in the different methods of acting, storytelling, Playbill and set design, radio theater, theatrical make-up, costuming, vocal and performing exercises. ◆ GET MOVING AND GET GROOVING (Grades K-2 and 3-5)

Here is an opportunity to explore the human body and fitness the fun way! Age appropriate games and fitness activities will be planned to show how exciting exercise can be!
