OVERVIEW:

To promote educational excellence in the Dumont Schools by facilitating resource sharing, innovation, and communication, it is the school's goal to provide Internet access to students and staff. The Internet is an electronic communications network that provides vast, diverse, and unique resources. This allows student and staff to interact with hundreds of thousands of computers and users on a worldwide basis. Use of the Internet by students is solely for the purpose of facilitating the exchange of information to further communication, education, and research and is consistent with the mission of the Dumont School District.

All school electronic communication sources, including the Internet and e-mail, are to be used in a responsible, efficient, ethical, and legal manner. Because access to the Internet provides connections to other computer systems world-wide, students and parents/guardians should understand that the school cannot control the content of the information and cannot guarantee against students encountering offensive content available on these systems. Dumont does not condone the use of offensive materials. We assume students will work in a responsible manner. Failure to do so will result in the revocation of the student's access privileges.

Students and their parents/guardians must be aware that access to the Internet will be withdrawn from students who do not respect the rights of others or who do not follow the rules and regulations established by the Dumont School District. Failure to follow the guidelines will subject violators to disciplinary action.
